It should be noted that many were short of ammunition, and virtually none had bayonets.
2. The main 3-sided redoubt should hold 1-2 stands. The rest of the American forces should be deployed in entrenchments.

N.B. You will note that often the number of stands does not correspond with the regiments shown on the American side. The Continental Army was a polyglot assembly of newly raised regiments, sad remnants of once-excellent units, and various oddments (some too small to include). A few (e.g. Delaware Continentals) were equal to anything the British fielded, but such units were few and far between, as many of the better formations had been sent to oppose Burgoyne in New York. If anything, the Americans are overrated in game terms, as they had not yet had the benefit of v. Steuben's training; but considering the quality of the British forces opposing them, rating them any lower than average would make victory for the American player impossible. Regarding commander ratings: Greene performed better tactically when under Washington's eye, and better strategically when not, so for now he rates as being "brilliant". Cornwallis is in my opinion grossly overrated, having blown it at Princeton and on other fields, and so draws an "average" rating.
