Notes on Junot's Troops: The French units were recently created as a result of Napoleon's reorganization of both the infantry and the dragoons. Junot's guns were crewed by men of the 5th Foot and 6th Horse Artillery Regiments, supplemented by 22 Wurzburg train personnel picked up during the march through that duchy. The Bavarian infantrymen were from the depots of the 4th and 8th Infantry Regiments and the 5th Light Battalion, all based at the fortress of Forchheim. The artillery had been captured from the Austrians, and was manned by Bavarian gunners from the depot at Forchheim.

Notes on Kienmayer's Troops: Kienmayer was fortunate to have a number of veteran units, but was also afflicted with Landwehr, who were often of poor quality. (The 2nd Chrudim, in fact, had been involved in a mutiny at the start of hostilities!). The "Brunswicker Black Corps", much beloved of wargamers everywhere, generally performed well during the campaign. Its strength fluctuated almost from day to day, and probably numbered no more than 700-900 infantry and cavalry on 8 July. It was competent,

but acquired a reputation for rather poor discipline. The paragons of indiscipline, however, were the members of the Hesse-Kassel Freikorps. Organised to return Prince-Elector Wilhelm IX to his throne in Kassel, it was composed of all manner of freebooters and rascals, very few of whom could claim Hesse as their place of birth. Despite extravagant titles, its units were poorly trained and plagued with internal dissension; they contributed little to the Austrian war effort and received a severe rebuke from Archduke Charles for their poor behavior. (For those to whom it makes a difference, the infantry element includes "Guard Grenadiers", Jagers, and Fusiliers. The cavalry element includes dragoons and hussars.)
